- II. **Point No. One: Don't Judge Others.** Look at your own shortcomings
 - a. Judging others is Hypocritical. Matt 7: 3
 - b. Matt. 7: 1-3
 - c. John 7:24. Judge not according to appearance
 - d. Righteous Judgment is different
 - e. John 12: 47 Jesus came not to Judge but to save the world- Purpose and Mission
 - f. The Apostle Paul- Do not Judge others or be a Stumbling Block to them. Rom. 14: 13
- III. **Point No. Two: Don't Cast Your Pearls Before Swine**
 - a. Matt. 7:6. Holiness and Pearls vs. Dogs and Pigs
 - b. Don't expend energy on those who don't appreciate it.
 - c. We should still try to help others.
 - d. Matt 5: 10-12 Blessed are you when men shall revile you....
 - e. Luke 10: 1-12- the Commission of the 70.
 - f. Shake the dust off of your feet.

- g. Matt 12: 15- Jesus healed them.
- h. Acts 13: 51. They were not received well in Antioch, and had to move on.

IV. Point No. Three: Be Consistent in our Asking

- a. Matt 7:7 Ask, Seek. You will find and the docs will be opened unto you.
- b. Don't be discouraged.
- c. Matt 7: 9 . Think of how we deal with our children.
- d. God is better than we are.
- e. Psa. 48:14. God is forever. He will be our Guide.
- f. Psa. 33: 20. We must wait for the Lord. He is our help and our shield.
- g. Matt. 6: 26. Look at the fowls of the air.
- h. When dealing with difficult people, Ask God for help, guidance, patience, faith.
